

**Infrastructure Quotation
Gas Act 1995 – Schedule 2 Consent**

National Grid plc is a public Gas Transporter within the meaning of the Act. By virtue of Paragraph 27 of Schedule 2 of the Act any officer authorised by a public gas transporter, after seven days' notice to the occupier of any premises, or to the owner of any premises which are unoccupied, may at all reasonable times, on production of some duly authenticated document showing his authority, enter the premises for the purpose of –

- a) placing a new pipe in the place of any existing pipe which has been lawfully placed; or
- b) repairing or altering any such existing pipe.
