## **National Grid Electricity Transmission - System Operator (SO) Incentives from April 2011 – BSUoS Seminar Details**

As part of this year's SO Incentive development process National Grid is holding a BSUoS seminar at the Ardencote Manor Hotel, in Claverdon, nr Warwick, on Tuesday 15 February 2011 (see details below). This seminar will follow the Full Operational Forum which is scheduled for the morning of the same date.

The seminar will provide National Grid's forecast range of 2011/12 BSUoS costs generated by the new energy model, which has been developed in-house during the course of the SO Incentive Review, and the newly procured constraint model (Plexos). This forecast range of costs (high, central and low) will be based upon scenarios for ex post, or out-turn data, to be fed into the models throughout the duration of the scheme.

It will also provide an overview of how BSUoS is calculated, how BSUoS processes might change (following implementation of an ex ante /ex post BSIS methodology), and how BSUoS information will be reported going forward.

Closer to the event National Grid will publish an agenda on the Electricity SO Incentives area of the National Grid website. Those parties that have registered for the event will be sent an e-mail to confirm when this material is available. Following the workshops, the presentations from the day will also be published on the National Grid website.
