

## Compliance Annual Report

## **Introduction**

Paragraph 9 of Special Condition N of the Electricity Transmission Licence (“Licence”) granted to National Grid Electricity Transmission plc (“NGET”) requires NGET to produce an annual report covering its compliance during the relevant year with Special Condition M of the licence and its implementation of the practices, procedures and systems adopted in accordance with the Compliance Statement, as approved by the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority. This is the annual report in respect of the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2007 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2007 (“period”).

## **Compliance during the relevant year**

NGET has been compliant with the obligations set out in Special Condition M of its licence throughout the period.

During the period, there have been four applications for connection which fall within the category described in paragraph 1 of Special Condition M, the latter being the trigger for Special Condition M to apply. NGET treated the information received in respect of all applications for connection as confidential.

Throughout the period, no applications for connection have been processed which fall within the definition of an 'alternative offer' as described in paragraph 3 of Special Condition M.

## **Implementation of the practices, procedures and systems adopted in accordance with the Compliance Statement**

Notwithstanding the absence of any applications for connection that would fall within the definition of an 'alternative offer' as described in paragraph 3 of Special Condition M, NGET has implemented a policy approved by the Authority, and remains prepared to deal with any such applications in a manner compliant with Special Condition M. This policy is described in a statement provided to the Authority and approved by it on 24th March 2005, a copy of which is available on the National Grid [website](#).

To further reinforce this policy, when applying for a connection pursuant to paragraph 1(b) of Standard Condition C8, applicants are required to identify any other application they have submitted which is intended as an alternative. This policy amendment has been reflected in a revised statement which was provided to the Authority in 2007.

## **Activities of the Compliance Officer**

The Compliance Officer has ensured that the above policy is appropriately communicated to be effective during the period. There have been no complaints and no investigations.
