

## **Consultation By the Transmission Access Standing Group**

At the CUSC Amendments Panel meeting on 16<sup>th</sup> August it was agreed that given the complexities and importance of Transmission Access, a short consultation should be undertaken on the TASG's report.

The purpose of the Consultation is to elicit the views of Industry participants and other interested parties as to whether the contents of the current report covers the range of options and issues for future Transmission Access arrangements (i.e. are there other viable options which have not been recorded) and whether you consider any of the issues raised in the report to be factually erroneous.

It should be noted that this is NOT a formal Consultation under the auspices of CUSC and is simply designed to allow the Group to gauge the views of a wider audience before completing its Terms of Reference.

Your views are being requested notwithstanding the fact that NGC have stated that they are considering bringing forward specific Amendment Proposals relating to Transmission Access based on the evolutionary strawman they presented to the TASG (and which was discussed at the TASG meetings in detail).
