**Consultation GB ECM 07 “Adjustment of seven year statement transmission entry capacity data for calculating 2007-08 TNUoS tariffs”**

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the consultation on the 2007-2008 TNUoS charges.

While EDF Trading Limited (EDFT) supports the exclusion of non-connected generators from the DCLF model, we were surprised with the changes in the proposed generation zones as compared to the 21 zones published in the Condition 5 report.

We would like to propose the following:

- Exclude the 3 generation projects from the transport and tariff, even though this reduces the TNUoS charges for the interconnector in the South East Zone
- Reconsider the generation zones and the allocation of a zone to Pembroke for 2007/08. The new zone can be created in subsequent years when the power station connects to the system. It may be appropriate to use zones such as those published for Condition 5

We believe this will be in line with NGET’s conditions and charging methodology.
