National Grid's TCMF Progress Report notes the limitations of the current Transcost transportation model. The Transcost model does not appear to be future proof to changes in flow directions arising from new entry flows at Milford Haven and the Isle of Grain, it is manually intensive to operate and requires User judgements to be made. Even if the Transcost model is modified so that it can continue to be used post 2007 (one of the options considered in GCM 01), users will find it difficult to operate themselves.

International Power (representing Saltend and Deeside power stations) supports the National Grid preferred option to move to the Transportation charging model in the event that UNC mod 116 is introduced or sooner in 2007 if GCM 01 is approved. We support the responses to these two mods given by the Association of Electricity Producers so will not replicate the arguments they have given in support of the use of the Transportation model.
