<p>CA030 - Amendment to add clarity to which information and data can be exchanged between NGET and the Scottish Transmission Owners in accordance with the STC. The amendment would add the allowance of disclosure of high level results of economic studies undertaken for assign investment planning options to a Transmission Owner. The amendment would also remove the references to specific Grid Code Clauses and instead refer more generally to the Grid Code.</p>		<p>The amendment proposal has been circulated to the STC Committee for comments. Comments to feed back via email and reported back at the October 2008 meeting. The STC Committee agreed that CA030 should be referred directly to Assessment and Report Phase and therefore the evaluation phase was not required. CA030 was sent out to industry consultation on the 13 October with views requested by 13 November 2008. Consultation closed on 13 November and responses were received. The Amendment Report was submitted to the Authority on 8 December 2008 for determination. Approval received from the Authority with an implementation date of the 21/1/06.</p>

<p>CA031 - has been raised as a consequence of CUSC Amendment Proposal CAP167 which addresses the problem by developing a Relevant Embedded Small Power Station (RESPS) Methodology which will form a basis for calculating RESPS Thresholds for each Grid Supply Point. NGET shall prepare a draft RESPS Methodology in consultation with owners and operators of Distribution Systems and relevant Transmission Licensees. Following this initial consultation NGET shall publish the RESPS Methodology on the NGET website for a period of 28 days for parties to provide comments to NGET.</p>		<p>The amendment proposal has been circulated to the STC Committee for comments. Comments to feedback via email and reported back at the January 2009 meeting. Evaluation phase to be completed by SPT and SHETL Draft Amendment Report to be approved at the February STC meeting. The STC Committee approved for CA031 to proceed to Company Consultation for a period of 10 days. The final report was submitted to the Authority on the 18/3/09 we are now awaiting a decision.</p>

Amendment Description <p>As result of CUSC Amendment Proposals for Transmission Access, this proposed amendment seeks to introduce a further granularity into the works that the TO will be required to identify by identifying those Transmission Reinforcement Works that are required to deliver the Local Capacity Nomination (LCN).</p>	Current status and progress <p>The Amendment Proposal was submitted to the STC Committee on 16th March 2009 and is awaiting a decision on whether it will need to go to the Evaluation Phase or straight to the Assessment and Report Phase. At the STC meeting in April, the committee members were not able comment on the matter and therefore the action was carried forward to the next meeting in May 2009.</p>
