The timetable for the 2011 CUSC Elections is as follows:

Nominations – the date by which nominations of candidates are to be received is no later than **5pm ,15th July 2011**.

Candidates and voting papers – the date by which the Code Administrator shall circulate a list of CUSC Panel Member candidates and voting papers is **22nd July 2011**.

Voting papers – the dates by which the voting papers are to be submitted to the Code Administrator is **12th August 2011**.

CUSC Election results – will be made known no later than **15th September 2011**.
