**REISSUE OF CONCLUSIONS REPORT FOR USE OF SYSTEM CHARGING  
METHODOLOGY MODIFICATION GB ECM-02**

On Friday I sent you the Conclusion Report for the Use of System Charging Methodology Modification proposal GB ECM-02. At the same time the report was circulated around the industry.

We were contacted this morning by a representative of the Chemical Industries Association seeking an explanation for the omission of their response to the consultation, from the appendix of responses attached to the Conclusion Report.

We have now confirmed that there was one response not included in the appendix and also excluded from the tally of responses. However, this response was considered in preparing the Conclusion Report and I can confirm that all the issues raised were included and addressed.

Whilst this event does not have a material bearing on the conclusions drawn in our methodology proposal, I do feel it is appropriate to produce a revised Conclusion Report containing the missing response and with the response analysis in the main body of the document updated. A revised version of the Conclusion Report is therefore attached.

Please note that the proposed implementation date is the 1 November 2005 and that this date is not affected by whether the 28 day 'veto' period commences on the 30 September or 3 October 2005. For the avoidance of doubt unless you advise us to the contrary we are assuming the veto period will expire on the 31 October 2005 (28 days from 3 October 2005).

I would like to reassure you that we take account of all responses to our consultations and at no stage were the issues raised by the CIA excluded from the development of the final proposals. This omission was a mistake in our counting of both the responses and the many

sub-issues within the responses, and we will be reviewing our internal processes to ensure that this sort of oversight does not reoccur in the future.

We will be e-mailing the revised conclusions report to all concerned parties and we will also be posting this report on the Charging Area of our web-site as soon as possible.
