

## **National Grid Transmission Charging Use of System Charging Methodology Modification Proposals: Errata**

Further to the publication of the Charging Methodology Modification Proposals UoSCM-M-10 and UoSCM-M-11 on 12<sup>th</sup> September, I am writing to advise of a number of errors found in the consultation documents.

### **UoSCM-M-10: Calculation of Locational TNUoS Tariffs**

The UoSCM-M-10 consultation document published on 12<sup>th</sup> September contained a misprinted date. Under Section 13: Responses to this Consultation, the closing date should have read **10<sup>th</sup> October 2003** and not 6<sup>th</sup> October 2003. Questions should be directed to Alex Thomason in the first instance.

### **UoSCM-M-11: Year Round TNUoS Charge**

The UoSCM-M-11 consultation document published on 12<sup>th</sup> September contained incorrect p/MWh figures. Under Section 6.6, the Year Round Generation charge should read **approximately 12.5p/MWh** (not 7p/MWh) and the Year Round Demand charge should read **approximately 34p/MWh** (not 19p/MWh).

### **Appendices to UoSCM-M-10 & UoSCM-M-11: Illustrative Draft of the Use of System Charging Methodology Statement**

In light of the incorrect figures noted above, Appendix 5 of the illustrative drafting of the Use of System Charging Methodology Statement should also be amended. The figures in section 4.5 should read "12.5p/MWh and 34p/MWh for generation and demand respectively".

Appendix TN-6 in the illustrative drafting (final pages of the document) contains flowcharts showing parties liable for TNUoS charges and the calculation of the charges. Please note that in the boxes in the Demand and Generation flowcharts which describe the Year Round charge, the unit of cost should read **p/MWh** and not £/MWh.
