The Service incurs a fixed application fee for each period applied for, and applications will not be deemed to have been received until this application fee has been paid. This fee may be partially refundable in limited circumstances outlined in the CUSC and in accordance with the Statement of the Use of System Charging Methodology.

The Service itself is subject to a Commercial Charge, this charge is a firm charge based on National Grids estimated cost of delivering C-LDTEC taking account of constraint cost that they would expect to incur. The charge is notified at the time the offer is made. The offer is available for acceptance for one business day.

The applicant will apply for a capacity (MW) and include a weekly maximum cost per MW. If the estimated weekly cost per MW exceeds the applicants weekly maximum then this week will not be included in the offer.

The access is tradable once granted.
