- 1) Actions from CISG on 02/12/05
- 2) Condition 2 Incremental cost of capacity
 - Open discussion on options for improving the cost reflectivity transparency of the incremental cost of capacity. Review the issues raised in the first two workshops and comment on a range of options developed by National Grid. Participants will then be given the opportunity to comment and further develop these ideas.
- 3) FMS metering
 - Discussion on the draft consultation document circulated prior to the meeting.
- 4) Condition 3 Intermittent Generation
 - Review National Grid internal analysis and present conclusions. Participants will then be invited to comment on these prior to a final report being drafted.
- 5) Non-standard connection
 - Concerns have been raised about the interaction between the charging methodologies and the GB Security and Quality Supply Standards. National Grid will review the issue and invite participants to provide initial comment on these and options for taking forward a review.
- 6) Connection Charging Methodologies
 - Open discussion to seek industry views on outstanding issues following the 'plugs' methodology implementation and opportunity for participants to highlight areas for further development.
- 7) Condition 4 Longer term fixed price access
 - Consider the interaction with other areas of work.
 - Consider the option for improving stability and predictability within the methodology for implementation in 2007.
