Draft Terms of Reference

1. To discuss and agree the principles contained in GCRP 03/21
2. To discuss and agree the definition of an intertripping scheme
3. To consider and identify the circumstances under which a Generator would be required to agree to (a) the installation of an intertripping scheme or an extension to an existing intertripping scheme and (b) the utilisation of such an intertripping scheme, as an obligatory condition of connection to the Transmission System.
4. To consider and identify the circumstances under which a Generator may be requested by NGC to agree to (a) the installation of an intertripping scheme and (b) the utilisation of such an intertripping scheme as an optional arrangement.
5. To consider the circumstances and procedure under which either a mandatory or optional intertripping scheme may be utilised by NGC.
6. To consider (3) and (4) with respect to existing intertripping schemes
7. To consider and identify the areas in which the Grid Code is deficient in the recognition and treatment of intertripping schemes, as identified above.
8. To propose changes to the Grid Code that would recognise the existence of intertripping schemes, in terms of provision and/or utilisation, as either a mandatory requirement or as an optional commercial service. The underlying assumption would be that intertripping schemes that do not qualify as being obligatory would be optional for the Generator. These intertripping schemes would not be identified in Appendix F3 of the Bilateral Connection Agreement.
9. The membership of the working group will be drawn from the GCRP and nominated representatives
10. The working group will aim to complete its work and report to the GCRP by ???
