GB ECM-22 Treatment of Exemptable Generation Connected to Embedded Transmission

We would like to thank all those parties who responded to the consultation. National Grid is the only party who can raise charging amendment consultations and following discussion at TCMF agreed to raise GB ECM-22 based on a proposal by E.ON UK. In parallel E.ON UK also brought forward a related modification in the BSC, P242, which was based on the same principle.

Ofgem has now rejected BSC modification P242¹. In light of this development E.ON UK has confirmed to us that they no longer believe GB ECM-22 should be progressed further as it would be implemented in the wrong context. Therefore National Grid will **not** be taking GB ECM-22 forward.
