Charging Issues Standing Group (1)

- Enable industry input into charging developments at an early stage
- Identify specific issues at TCMF for Standing Group consideration
- TCMF direct issues to be considered at Standing Group
- Resource considerations
- Main period of working group activity: February - July

Charging Issues Standing Group (2)

- Amend TCMF TOR
 - Relationship with Standing Group
- Modify DCLF TOR to become Charging Issues Standing Group
- CISG can establish specific sub-groups if appropriate
- CISG formally reports to TCMF
- Circulate revised TCMF and CISG TOR prior to next meeting

Charging Issues Standing Group (3)

- Issues for consideration at CISG
 - Managing changes to charges
 - NHH and HH Switching
 - Alternative zoning techniques

NHH and HH Switching

- NHH metered users pay demand TNUoS consumption tariff based on usage between 4-7pm each day
- HH metered users pay demand TNUoS TRIAD charges based on peak winter demand
- A switch from HH to NHH mid year could result in the avoidance of a full year's charge
- A switch from NHH to HH mid year could result in paying more than a full years charge
