Pre-implementation Workshops

From 1st October 2007 there will be a significant change in the way that National Grid publishes some of the key data items over the internet. Much of the key market data published on the internet is being moved to a new publication platform that will offer a more flexible and user friendly experience.

More information about the content and functionality of the new system can be found in the Market Information Provision Initiative booklet published on our website.

In order to try and ensure that the implementation proceeds as smoothly as possible, we have organised two pre-implementation workshops. The aim of the workshops is to give potential system users a preview of the new site, show what and how data will be displayed and how it can be downloaded, etc.

Throughout the half day workshop participants will be able to put questions directly to the individuals responsible for the operation of the web site. We will be discussing automated data downloads and Application Programmable Interfaces (API) as a part of the workshop, but would consider running a separate workshop dedicated to APIs if there is sufficient demand.
