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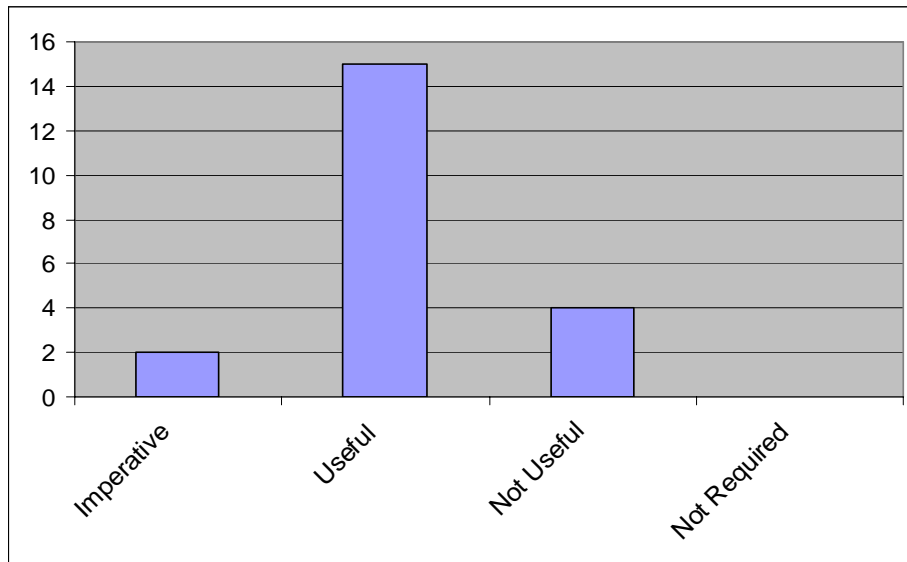

# UNC Modification 0206

- Title:
  - Summer and Winter Assured Pressure Periods
- Raised by:
  - National Grid NTS on 12 March 2008
- Status:
  - Allocated to Transmission Workstream (03 April 2008)
- Next stage:
  - May UNC Panel for decision on consultation
  - Or Withdrawal

# UNC Modification 0206

- Main Features
  - Replace current minimum assured NTS Offtake Pressures for Gas Year with two sets
    - Winter 01 November to 31 March
    - Summer 01 April to 31 October
    - Continues to apply to 06.00 and 22.00
  - Applies to NTS/LDZ Offtakes only
    - NTS Supply Points covered by NExAs

- Title:
  - Amendment to the QSEC Auction Timetable
- Raised by:
  - National Grid NTS on 12 December 2007
- Status:
  - Rejected by Ofgem on 13 March 2008

# UNC Modifications 0187/A

- Title:
  - Alterations to the RMSEC Auction to Accommodate Transfer and Trade of Capacity Between ASEPs
- Raised by:
  - (0187) National Grid NTS on 12 December 2007
  - (0187A) British Gas on 23 January 2008
- Status: With Ofgem for decision
  - (0187) Feb Mod Panel supported (9 out of 10)
  - (0187A) Feb Mod Panel supported (7 out of 10)
  - 7 preferred 0187, 1 preferred 0187A

- Title:
  - Reform of the NTS Offtake Arrangements
- Raised by:
  - (0116/V) National Grid NTS 13.09.06/16.11.06
  - (0116A) E.ON 12.10.06
  - (0116B/BV) RWE 13.10.06/16.11.06
  - (0116C/CV/CVV) Centrica 17.10.06/16.11.06/21.12.06
  - (0116VD) Scotia Gas Networks 22.11.06
- Status: With Ofgem for reconsideration
  - Ofgem approved 0116V
  - Competition Commission quashed decision

# UNC Modifications 0116 etc

- Main Features
  - Retain Status Quo by deleting sunset clause
    - 0116A
  - Introduce User commitment for flat capacity, retain status quo for flex
    - 0116CVV
  - Introduce User commitment for both flat and flex capacity
    - 0116V, 0116BV, 0116VD

# UNC Modifications 0195/A

- Title:
  - Introduction of Enduring NTS Exit Capacity Arrangements
- Raised by:
  - (0195) RWE (on behalf of Review Group 0166) 17.01.08
  - (0195A) E.ON 21.02.08
- Status: To Panel following close-out
  - (0195) 19/24 Reps supported (1 qualified)
  - (0195A) 21/24 Reps supported (3 qualified)
  - Preferences – complicated as included 0116 set

# UNC Modifications 0195/A

- Main Features
  - Both Proposals
    - Introduce User commitment for flat capacity, retain status quo for flex
    - Flex information to be placed on website
    - Staged “ARCA type” commitments
    - Enduring capacity can be booked outside annual windows
    - Less auctions than 0116CVV etc

# UNC Modifications 0195/A

- Main Features

- 0195A

- Entitlement to Daily Interruptible Capacity up to Maximum Supply Point Offtake Rate
    - Entitlement withdrawn when forecast above 80% peak day
    - Overruns are deemed to be firm bookings with full User commitment.

# UNC Modification 0198

- Title:
  - Extension of the Current Sunset Clauses for Registration of Capacity at NTS Exit Points
- Raised by:
  - National Grid NTS 30.01.08
- Status: With Ofgem for decision
  - March Mod Panel supported (unanimous)

# UNC Modification 0198

- Main Features
  - Extend current Exit Capacity arrangements to October 2012
  - This would allow first allocations to take place in July 2009

- Raised by:
  - National Grid NTS 07.11.07
- Status: Implemented 07.04.08

# UNC Modification 0182

- Main Features
  - Clarify Publication of LNG Stock Data at Import Terminals
  - If data not available at D+1 don't publish
