Hi Stuart,

At Ecotricity we are a retail supplier just in England and Wales. We are only a small supplier with a few HH and approx 5000 NHH domestic and small commercial customers. As such there is not much opportunity to model changes in TNUOs etc. However, it would appear that the proposed changes to TNUOs with the introduction of BETTA could cost us at least a 30% increase in charges, which is a significant component of our electricity cost. I would appreciate your comments on how the small independent suppliers are being safeguarded in the transfer to BETTA.
