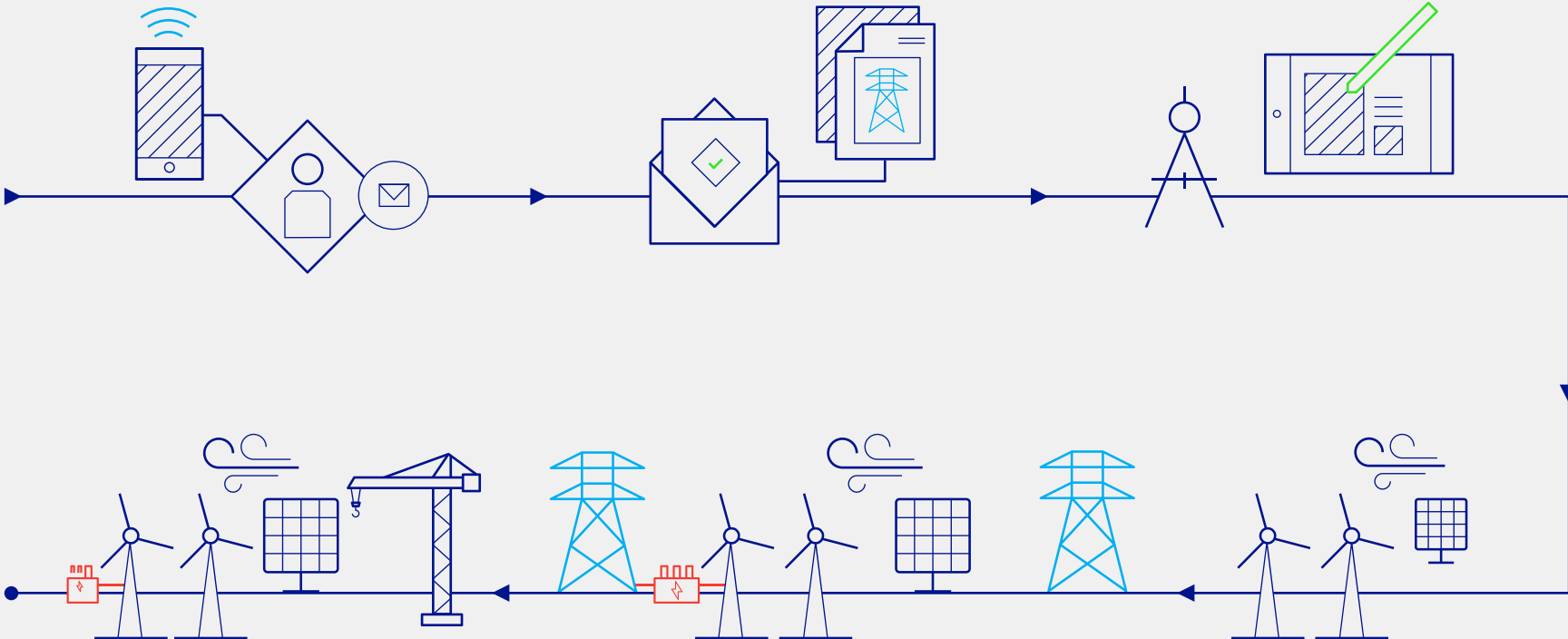
Applying to connect

If you choose to connect to us, an application will need to be submitted to the Electricity System Operator (ESO). The ESO will work with both you and us to facilitate the necessary agreements.

Designing your connection

Having submitted your application, and paid the relevant fees, your dedicated Account Manager will be in touch to discuss your requirements. Our team will find the most economical solution for your connection. Once designed, you will receive your offer from the ESO.



Maintaining your connection to the end

Through the life of your connection, it's possible both our plant and yours will require maintenance. Our Engineering and Consultancy Solutions team can discuss the services we offer to assist you with your maintenance.

As your plant approaches the end of its life, you can discuss with your Account Manager what steps are required for termination/disconnection.

Connecting to and operating the system

Just prior to connection, your plant will go through the commissioning process in readiness for operation on the system. Once connected, the ESO will balance demand and supply to ensure the security and quality of electricity supply across the Transmission System.

Building your connection

Once your offer has been signed, we will progress consenting and construction of our works for your project. Our team will engage with you and develop your connection to the next stage.
