National Grid Electricity Transmission is consulting on proposals to build a new substation in the local area, approximately 1.4km from Navenby, Lincolnshire.

Overview

۲

The way we generate electricity in the UK is changing rapidly, and we are transitioning to cheaper, cleaner and more secure forms of energy such as new solar farms. There is a shift towards renewable energy sources, meaning there is also a greater demand on our network to connect new sources of electricity and customers. The proposed substation at Navenby is in response to the increase in connection requests in the area from solar developers.

In England and Wales, the electricity transmission network is owned, built and maintained by National Grid Electricity Transmission (NGET).


