Norwich to Tilbury is a proposal for a new electricity transmission connection. It will play an important part in achieving the government's targets to increase offshore wind energy to over 50 GW by 2030 and helping the UK move towards net zero.

From 10 April – 26 July 2024, we held a public consultation, inviting local communities to share their views on our proposals.
