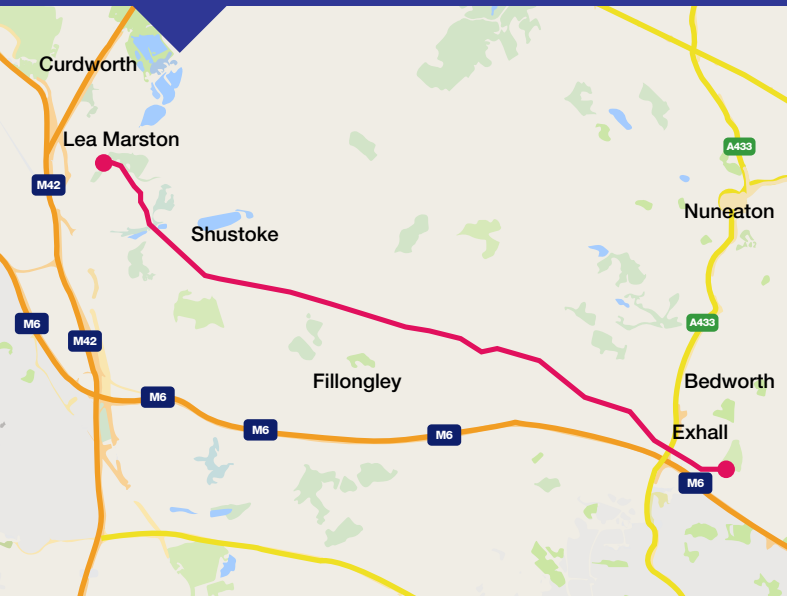


Coleshill to Bedworth

Work in your area - March to Autumn 2017



Overhead line refurbishment work between Hams Hall substation near Coleshill and Coventry substation near Bedworth. The pylon route passes through Hams Hall National Distribution Park in Lea Marston, Shustoke, Fillongley, Wood End, Bedworth West, Goodyers End and Exhall.

What?

- Work across a 20km (12.5 mile) route from substation to substations.
- Engineers working overhead
- Your electricity supply will not be affected by the work
- Full refurbishment of 60 pylons including the replacement of the wires, insulators and fittings and painting.
- Work across a 20km (12.5 mile) route from substation to substations.

Why?

- To keep the network in first class working order and meet future electricity demands.

Footpath closures

We'll temporarily close some sections of road and footpaths to protect public safety and allow us to access the pylon sites. Much of this work will be done when the power supply is switched off between May and August 2017.
